**COMMINGLING ORDER PLC-162**

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle South Carlsbad-Morrow (Prorated Gas - 73960) and Frontier Hills-Strawn (Gas - 77190) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: F.H. "29" Federal Com Lease Well No. 1  
Description: NE/4 SE/4 of Section 29, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, and

Lease: F.H. "28" State Lease Well No. 1  
Description: NE/4 NW/4 of Section 28, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, NMPM,

All in Eddy County, New Mexico.

Gas production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling. Oil production will be measured individually and sold at each well's tank battery.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The common gas sales meter is located in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 28, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.


FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
