In reference to the above, Nadel and Gussman is ordered to shut-in said well on December 6<sup>th</sup> for failure to comply with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's rules and regulations, specifically Rule 1105.A.

On October 10<sup>th</sup>, November 11<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>, I have contacted your office requesting that Nadel and Gussman submit a <u>complete</u> set of electric logs. As of this date, only a sonic and dual laterolog has been received.
