

## ABSTRACT

New Mexico Archaeological Services, Inc., representing DEVON ENERGY CORPORATION, undertook six Class III surveys of Bureau of Land Management lands scheduled to be impacted by the construction of six drill locations and their associated access roads. Field work was conducted under sunny, partly cloudy conditions with moderate southwesterly winds during mid- and late-afternoon on 25 June and under partly sunny conditions with southeasterly winds during the morning on 26 June. Each location will measure 400 X 400 ft (actual area surveyed 4.44 acres). The Todd "14" Federal Well No. 2 access road will measure 100 x 200 ft (actual area surveyed 0.46 acre). The Todd "13" Federal Well No. 1 access road will measure 100 X 550 ft (actual area surveyed 1.26 acres). The Todd "13" Federal Well No. 2 access road will measure 100 X 950 ft (actual area surveyed 2.18 acres). The Todd "23" Federal Well No. 13 access road will measure 100 X 2300 ft (actual area surveyed 5.20 acres). The Todd "23" Federal Well No. 10 access road will measure 100 X 1400 ft (actual area surveyed 3.21 acres). The Todd "23" Federal Well No. 9 access road will measure 100 X 1100 ft (actual area surveyed 2.53 acres). Total surveyed acreage 41.48 acres. They will be situated in Sections 14, 13 and 23, T23S, R31E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. One isolated manifestation (IM) was recorded during the Todd "23" Federal Well No. 13 survey. No cultural properties were recorded during the Todd "14" Federal Well No. 2, Todd "13" Federal Well Nos. 1 and 2 and Todd "23" Federal Well Nos. 10 and 9 surveys. Clearance is suggested for all proposed locations and access roads as now proposed.
