

## SURFACE USE AND OPERATING PLAN

### 1. Existing Roads

- A. This location will be staked by John West Surveying, Co. of Hobbs, New Mexico and the well site and elevation plat for the proposed TODD "23G" FEDERAL #32 will be submitted as Exhibit #2.
- B. All roads into the location are depicted in Exhibit #3. New construction from the County road will be used to access the location. New construction will conform to the specifications outlined in item 2 below.
- C. Directions to location: Travel west-northwest from Jal, NM approximately 35 miles on State Highway 128 to County Road 798, just into Eddy County from Lea County, thence north approximately 2 miles, turn west (left) onto the Todd 26 Federal entry road. Go approximately 0.3 mile to Todd 26 #2 SWD location, turn north (right) and travel approximately 1 mile (passing Todd 23O Federal #1) the existing Todd 23G Federal #7 well site and the proposed Todd "23G" Federal #32 location.

### 2. Proposed Access Road

Exhibit #3 shows the existing entry road to the proposed TODD "23G" FEDERAL #32 location. If necessary any additional road construction will be as follows.

- A. The maximum width of the road will be fifteen (15) feet.
- B. It will be crowned and made of six (6) inches of rolled and compacted caliche. Water will be deflected, as necessary, to avoid accumulation and prevent surface erosion.
- C. Surface material will be native caliche. This material will be obtained from a BLM approved pit nearest in proximity to the location.
- D. The average grade will be approximately 1%.
