DETAILS OF WORK

The well was drilled on 11-11-60 and the telephone well was found to contain water from 1100-12 at a rate of 10 barrels/hr.. A 2 1/2" pipe was pulled and a 20 sec co. was placed at 1200' and a 20 sec pipe at 1300' and a 20 sec pipe at the surface. A permanent 4' x 4" marker was placed on the well site. The work involved to the original contour and location showed a location not ready for operation.
