Enclosed are Forms C-105 and C-122 for the subject well. The multipoint back pressure test was run on December 31, 1975 and the well is currently shut-in. This well was originally drilled by Gulf Oil Company in 1962, as the Chinaberry Draw Unit No. 1 and was subsequently plugged and abandoned. Total depth was 12,200".

No additional deviation surveys or electric logs were run while re-entering this well. As noted in the C-105, 5½" casing was set at 11,654' with plug back of 11,611'. If additional information is required, please advise.
