Humble State Well No. 1, Unit D, Section 16,

New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

The subject well was plugged in violation of Rule 1105 of the Commission Rules and Regulations. This Rule requires that no plugging operations be started until the District Office of the Commission has approved the Notice of Intention to Plug. In addition, the operator failed to file a complete record of the well on Form C-105 with the log or logs run on the well as required by Rule 1108.

Inasmuch as the Commission has reason to believe that the subject well was not adequately plugged, we must make formal demand on you, as surety on the bond for the subject well, to drill out the surface plug and proceed to plug the well in a manner approved by the Commission Supervisor in Artesia, New Mexico. This work is to be completed no later than April 1, 1960.
