DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Mr. C.L. Tallmadge, now deceased, was employed as our field agent in connection with the drilling of the well and supposedly made all reports, etc. to your office. Mr. E.B. Guess, the drilling contractor, is also now deceased. Mr. David Chavez, Jr. and Mr. Tallmadge were present at the time the drilling contract was completed and the well plugged. I recall having a conversation later with Tallmadge and he advised me that the well had been properly plugged before the drilling rig was moved off. This was also verified by Mr. Guess, the drilling contractor, when I asked him about it at the time final payment was made to him on his drilling contract. I have only the statements of these parties, however, and no personal knowledge in the matter.
