Gentlemen:

In reply to your letter dated March 9, 1959 written to the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland concerning the Plugging Bond of Mr. T.F. Vanderlaan on his Humble State SW 46, Unit D, Section 16, T-26-S, R-26-E, Eddy County, New Mexico please be advised that this hole that you refer to was drilled to the approximate depth of 200 feet by a small rotary and they were unable to go any farther. There was 50 feet of 8 5/8 inch casing cemented in this hole. There was know water encountered and we have of this date filled this hole with cement and covered same as you requested. Also the hole that was drilled 20 feet from this well which had a marker cemented but not stenciled has of this date been stenciled and the ancor hole wires have been cut as requested by Mr. Armstrong.
