Your application to convert and operate as a water disposal well the No. 1 Gulf Pipkin on oil and gas lease Las Cruces 070791-A, located 330/S and 605/E sec. 34, T. 26 S., R. 29 E., W.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, by injecting waste water into the Delaware formation through open hole section 2899-2905 feet, is hereby approved subject to the following:
