FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

1200' of salt water was encountered at 3590 and increased to 3638, total depth. The top of the Delaware was found at 3460 and Delaware sand at 3515. We will use mud in plug from T. D. to approximately 3200' and rip 7" casing to remove. The process will be used in recovering the 10" at 1450', the 12" at 1095, and the 15" at 860'.

A cement plug will be placed at the bottom of the hole, one will be placed at the base of the salt, another will be placed at the top of the salt, and a cement marker will be placed at the surface. Work started 11-12-37.
