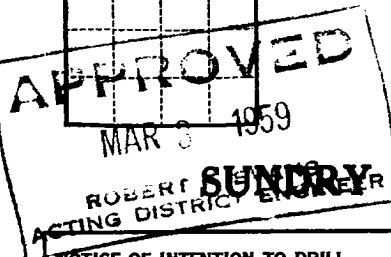

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill to a total depth of 3500 ft. with rotary and attempt to complete in the Delaware. We propose to set 300 feet of 7-5/8 inch casing and cement with 125 sacks. 4 1/2-inch oil string will be set @ 2400' depth and cemented with 100 sacks cement.
