DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Proposal is to set 8-5/8" O.D. 20 lb. casing into the red bed at approximately 200 feet and circulate cement to the surface. To drill approximately 150 feet into the Delaware sand to a total depth of 4200 feet. To set 4-1/2" O.D. 9.50 lb. casing at total depth and cement with 125 sacks of cement. Completion will be through perforations opposite Delaware formation after acid and fracture treatment. The well will be rotary cored and logs run. Approximate spudding date will be April 20, 1960 with rotary tools. (Lease agreement requires spudding date must be prior to May 1, 1960.)
