Set 3370' 4 1/2" OD 9.50# casing Optiscoped, Magnetic API Drifted. Cemented with 100 sacks Lone Star CL "C" 5/10 of 1% CFR-2 3# salt per sack #3 sand mixed 5# per sack Type "E" float collar, 3 centralizers.

Desire to inject salt water into interval 3323'-3326' through tubing with HOWCO R-3 packer set at 3268' with use of salt water pump from gathering system in Brushy Draw (Delaware) field in compliance with "Open Pit" Order of New Mexico Conservation Commission.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
