1. Set 1 jt conductor casing.
2. Drill to 200' or through water sands w/ 12 1/4" hole w/Cable Tools.
3. Set 200' 9 5/8" 32.3 H-40 csg. w/mud.
4. Drill to 600' or Delaware sand w 8 1/2" hole w/Cable Tools.
5. If Delaware sand productive, circulate cement 9 5/8" csg.
6. Clean out to bottom and run 4 1/2" 9.5 J-55 csg. for production and cement across prospective pay sands.
7. Perforate and test well for completion. Fracture treat if necessary.
8. If Delaware sand not productive, pull 9 5/8" csg.
9. Plug and abandon to U.S.G.S. specifications.

NOTE: If water is encountered in 8 1/2" hole below 9 5/8" csg., a water string of 7" csg. will be run w/mud and drilling will continue to Delaware sand in 6 1/4" hole. If Delaware sand is productive, this string will be pulled before 9 5/8" csg. is cemented.

IN ABOVE SPACE DESCRIBE PROPOSED PROGRAM: If proposal is to deepen or plug back give location of present productive zone and proposed new productive zone. 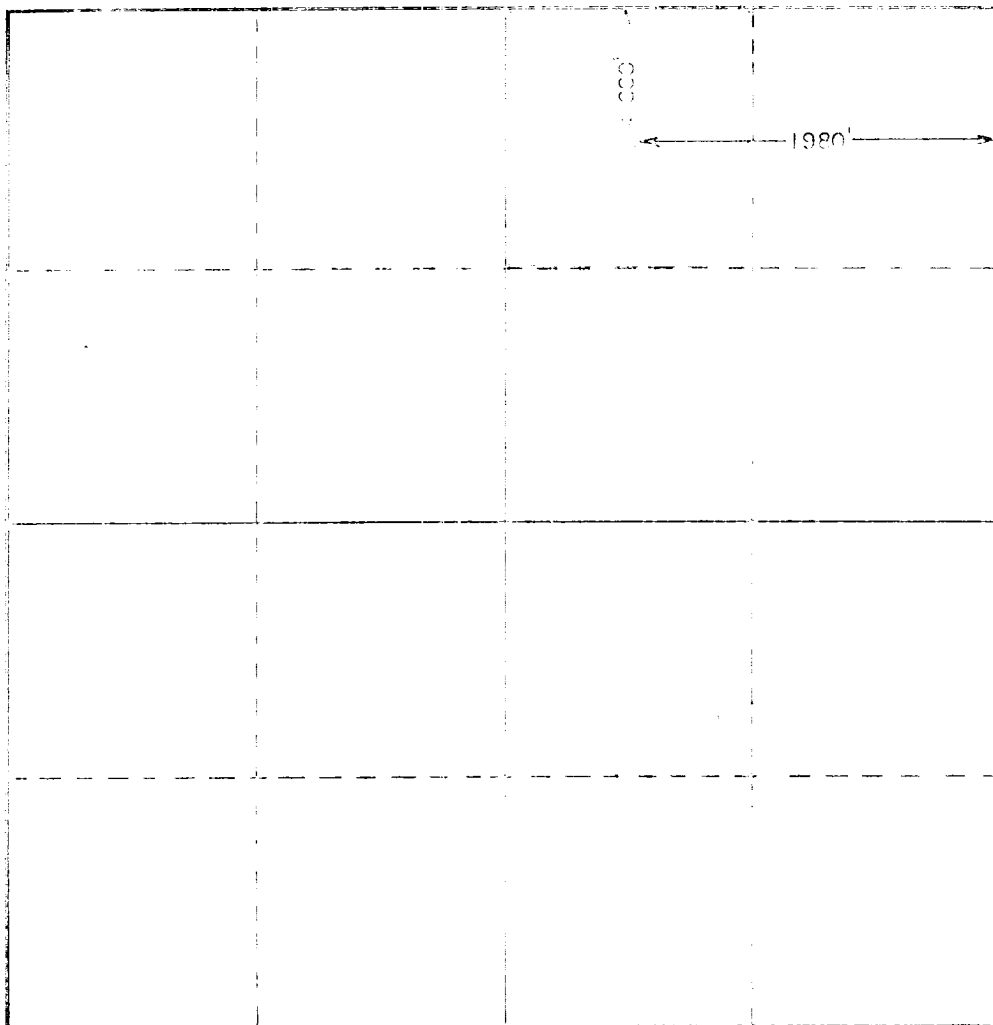
