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The surface use and operations plan for the practice of the MENAL are U.S. GEULUNALI are as follows:

1. Existing Roads

Gentlemen:

- a. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a general highway map showing location of the proposed well as staked. Go South out of Carlsbad, New Mexico on U.S. Highway 62 and turn left onto the Old Caverns Highway for 10.4 miles South to the intersection with Highway 396. Continue South on the unpaved road 3.8 miles and turn right through the cattleguard. Follow the main road, taking the left fork, for 1.5 miles. The proposed new road runs for 2300' Southeast from the existing road in the SE corner, Section 35, T-24-S, R-26-E to the SW corner of the proposed location.
- b. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing all existing roads within a one mile radius of the well site and the planned access road.
- Planned Access Roads 2.
 - a. Length and Width: Required new road will be 2300 feet long and 12 feet wide and constructed of caliche compacted and watered to a depth of six (6) inches. The new road is labeled and color-coded red on Exhibits "A" and "B".
 - b. Turnouts: None required.
 - c. Culverts: None required.
 - d. Cuts and Fills: A cut of six (6) feet on the Southwest side and a fill of four (4) feet on the Northeast side of the proposed new location will be required. A minor cut will be required on the proposed new road where it enters the Southwest corner of the location.
 - Gates and Cattleguards: None required. e.
