DRAWWORKS

Continental-Emsco "B" Line S45E dual trailer rig with Foster automatic catheads, 2-engine Oilbath chain drive, Parkersburg 15" double auxiliary brake, Lebus grooving for 1 1/8" line, and automatic driller.

ENGINES

Two D-3306T Caterpillar diesels (220 h.p. each) with Twin-Disc torque converters. One D-353TA Caterpillar diesel with Twin-Disc clutch and Oilbath chain drive unitized with pump. 890 h.p. total on rig.

DRILLING MAST

Lee C. Moore 97', 350,000#, telescoping, and mounted on drawworks trailer. Lee C. Moore 9'H x 10'W x 17'L, 350,000# trailer type substructure.

MUD PUMP

Ideco MM700-F 7 1/2" x 16", 700 h.p. with forged steel fluid end and Hydral pulsation dampener.

TRAVELING EQUIPMENT

Ideco 110-ton combination shorty block and hook with four 36" sheaves for 1 1/8" line and Gray E-44 150-ton swivel.

LIGHTING SYSTEM

Vapor-proof throughout. 10kw Lima generator, Mission 3" x 2" washdown pump, and auxiliary air compressor powered by Detroit Diesel 2-71 engine.

DRILL PIPE

4" 14.00# Grade E with HTC 5 1/2" OD, 4" FH Flashweld tool joints.

DRILL COLLARS

As required for popular hole sizes.

BLOWOUT PREVENTERS

Shaffer LWS 10"-900 Series double hydraulic. Hydral GK 10"-900. 80 gallon capacity, 2500 PSI, 4-valve air and electric powered accumulator. Choke manifold as needed.

WATER STORAGE

J & J 500 bbl. horizontal skidded fresh water tank.

HOUSING

Air-conditioned 20' house trailer. Trailer mounted 8' x 30' cantilever raising doghouse.
