

INSTRUCTIONS

General: This form is designed for submitting a complete and correct well completion report and log on all types of lands and leases to either a Federal agency or a State agency as both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the Federal and/or State office. See instruction 28 on items 22 and 24, and 53, below regarding separate reports for separate completions.

If not added prior to the time this summary record is submitted, copies of all currently available logs (drillers, geologists, sonde and core analysis, all types of geologic logs, etc.) and all pressure tests, and directional surveys, should be attached hereto, to the extent required by applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. All attachments should be identified on this form as per item 25.

Item 31: If there are no applicable State requirements, location on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Check box 31a or 31b of Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 14: In those cases where observation is used as reference (where not otherwise shown) for depth measurements given in other stages on this form and in any attachment to items 22 and 24: If this well is completed for separate production from more than one interval zone (multiple completion), so state in item 22 and in item 24 show the production interval, or intervals, top(s), bottom(s), and name(s) (if any) for only the interval reported in item 53. Submit a separate report (pages on this form, as suitably indicated, for each additional interval to be separately produced, showing the additional data pertinent to such interval.

Item 27: *Stratigraphic Column:* Attached supplemental records for this well should show the details of any multiple stage cementing and the location of the cementing tool. Item 33: Submit a separate completion report on this form for each interval to be separately produced. (See instruction for items 22 and 24 above.)
