This well is now non-commercial in the Morrow Sands and the various plug backs to the lower Wolfcamp Detrital Sands

The plan is to plug back to the Lower Cherry Canyon Sands at 5594 feet to 5600 feet and 5650 feet to 5710 feet and perf two shots per foot (shoot both ways each time) and to acidize with 30,000 gallons plus appropriate sand.

Clean up the works and put the well on production, probably under pump.

Plan to start within six weeks after approval by BLM.
