
Dear Mr. Huzzey:

Reference is made to your application dated March 1, 1995 for a non-standard Wolfcamp gas well location for your existing Marquardt Federal Well No. 2 (API No. 30-015-22936), which was drilled in 1979 and completed in the White City-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool at a standard gas well location (pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the White City-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-2429-A, as amended) 1650 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of Section 12, Township 25 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the well will be dually completed in both the White City-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and Wolfcamp formation, and pursuant to Division General Rule 104.B(1)(a) said location is considered to be unorthodox in the Wolfcamp interval.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(1), the above-described unorthodox Wolfcamp gas well location is hereby approved. Further, the N/2 of said Section 12 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for Wolfcamp gas production.
