7. METHOD OF HANDLING DISPOSAL:

There is a 2' x 2' steel trash pit with the drill rig.

A trash pit is dug and the trash is buried.

At the completion of drilling, the site and surrounding area will be cleaned up and all burnable material will be put in the burn pit and buried. All foreign material will be buried.
