

- B. Unguarded pits, if any, containing fluids will be fenced off until they have been backfilled.

11. TOPOGRAPHY

- A. The wellsite and access route are located on a ripple-marked surface sloping gently to the southeast into the Black River area.
- B. The soils are clay loams and silty clay loams.
- C. The vegetation cover at the wellsite area is moderately dense with shinnery, acacia, greasewood, and assorted grasses.
- D. No wildlife was observed but it is likely that rabbits, lizards, insects, and rodents traverse the area.
- E. The Black River streambed is primarily a dry wash except in the rainy season, and trends along the south half of the lease in a southwesterly direction.
- F. The wellsite is located on federal surface.
- G. There is no evidence of any archaeological, historical, or cultural sites in the vicinity of the location.
