

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES.

- A. No facilities owned at present.
- B. If productive, facilities will be as follows:
  - (1) On the well pad.
  - (2) Not known at this time.
  - (3) Not know at this time.
  - (4) Locking devices to be placed on all production equipment. No unattended open pits or reservoirs to be left at the well site.
- C. The land will be restored as much as possible to the original condition.

5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY.

- A. Drilling water is to be purchased and hauled to the proposed drilling site.
- B. Water to be hauled by trucks.
- C. No well is to be drilled.

6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS.

- A. Caliche is to be excavated and hauled from an existing caliche pit located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, T24S, R32E. (See Archaeologist Report).
- B. On Federal Land.
- C. The pit to be used is shown on Exhibit "F" and is in Section 7-T24S-R32E. The materials taken from this pit are to be used to build the access road and the drilling location pad.
- D. This pit is very close to an existing county road.
