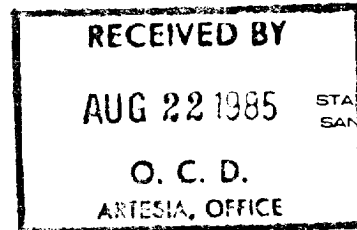

Dear Mr. Boling:

Your request for a temporary pressure increase on the subject well from 660 psig to 800 psig has been reviewed. In view of the rapid development of the area and the substantial increase of produced water on your disposal system, you will be allowed to temporarily increase the surface injection pressure on the subject well to 800 psig until September 30, 1985. This should allow you time to perform the necessary work to commence operation of your Federal "AZ" SWD Well No. 1, which will alleviate the overload on your current disposal system. After September 30, 1985 you shall be required to reduce the surface injection pressure back down to 660 psig until such time a valid step-rate test is submitted and accepted by this office.
