Mr. Moore:

According to your C-115, Monthly Operator's Report, oil from the above captioned well is being sold. Our files show that an allowable has never been assigned to this well, other than a testing allowable for the month of January, only.

We do not have the Completion Reports, Deviation Survey, or copies of any logs that have been run on this well. There has been no C-104, Request for Allowable, applied for, therefore you have never been issued an allowable. The well is being produced illegally.

The Santa Fe office will send out a computerized list showing that your well is over produced and must be shut-in.

Also, on your request for a Testing Allowable, you show the transporter as Charter Crude Oil Company, but on the C-115 you list Falcon Crude as the transporter. We have no address for Falcon Crude, please send us the Form C-104 showing transporter.

Please file all necessary paper on this well as soon as possible, so that everything can be brought up to date and made current on this well.
