- 1. EXISTING ROADS - Area map, Exhibit "B", is a reproduction of the New Mexico General Hi-Way Map. Existing and proposed roads are shown on the exhibit. All roads shall be maintained in a condition equal that which existed prior to the start of construction.
 - A. Exhibit "A" shows the proposed development well site as staked.
 - B. From Malaga, New Mexico Post Office take US 285, go 12 miles south, turn east on El Paso Pipeline road, go 4 miles to low water crossing, continue 3 miles east. turn north on lease road approximately 1.2 miles. Turn East 660', Turn South 660' to location.
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS - Approximately 1320' of new access road will be constructed.
 - The access road will be crowned and ditched to a 12'00" wide **A**. travel surface with a 40' right-of-way.
 - B. Gradient on all roads will be less than 5.00%.
 - C. Turnouts will be constructed as necessary.
 - D. If needed, road will be surfaced with a minimum of 4" caliche. This material will be obtained from a local source.
 - E. Centerline for the new access road has been flagged. Earthwork will be as required by field conditions.
 - F. Culverts in the access road will not be used. The road will be constructed to utilize low water crossings for drainage as required by the Topography.
