Texasco Exploration and Production, Inc. respectively seeks permission to flare test gas at the Cotton Draw Unit #86, Unit Ltr "J", 2600' FSL and 1500' FEL, Sec 12, T-25-S, R31-E, Eddy County, New Mexico, for a 6 to 8 hour period on one day during the week of June 4-8, 2001. The amount of gas to be flared will be less than or equal to 390 mcf. A pending contract well testing service will be on-site during this period of time. The purpose of this procedure is to test the well at a back pressure of 100 psi. This is required pre-engineering work to accumulate data for a compression upgrade for the Cotton Draw Unit gas wells #76, #84, and #86 in the near future.
