- <u>C. Flora and Fauna:</u> The vegetation cover is moderate. It includes range grasses, weeds, and mesquite bushes. Wildlife in the area is that typical of a semi-arid desert land and includes coyotes, rabbits, rodents, reptiles, hawks, dove, quail and other small birds.
- <u>D. Ponds and Streams:</u> There are no rivers, ponds, or streams in the area. Red Bluff reservoir on the Pecos River is located approximately 2 miles to the South across the state line in Texas.
- E. Residences and Other Structures: There is no occupied dwelling or other structures within 3/4 miles of the well site.
