This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, and the procedure to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after the completion of all operations so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the proposed operations.

1. Existing Roads

Exhibit "A" is a portion of a topographic map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. At the intersection of State Road 249 and the Jermina Road, 60 north approximately 2 miles to Katrina Road. Turn west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Teresa Road, 60 north approximately 4 miles then left into location.

2. Planned Access Roads

A. Length and Width

The proposed access road will be approximately 3300 feet in length and 16 feet in width. The proposed access road will enter the location from the southeast.

B. Surfacing Material

6" caliche rolled and packed.

C. Maximum Grade

Three Percent (3%)

Natural drainage.
