Subject well was plugged and abandoned March 24, 1936. Baker plug was set @ 7080' with 75 sz cement on top. Top of cement @ 6887'. A 90 sz cement plug was set @ 3435-3372. A 25 sz cement plug and a marker were set in top of 13-3/8" casing. 1436 feet of 9-5/8" casing was pulled and recovered.
