C) Water Wells

A fresh water supply well approximately one mile away may be utilized for the drilling of this well.

POINT 6: SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

A) Materials

Caliche required for construction will be obtained from an existing pit as required by the Bureau of Land Management before the commencement of construction activities.

B) Land Ownership

Federally owned.

C) Materials Foreign to the Site

No construction materials foreign to this area are anticipated for this drill site.

D) Access Roads

No additional access roads are required.

POINT 7: METHODS FOR HANDLING WASTE MATERIAL

A) Cuttings

Cutting will be contained in the reserve pit.

B) Drilling Fluids

Drilling fluids will be contained in the reserve pit.

C) Produced Fluids

No substantial production of water is expected during drilling. Hydrocarbon fluid or other fluids that may be produced during testing will be retained in test tanks. Prior to cleanup operations, any hydrocarbon material in the reserve pit will be removed by skimming or burning as the situation would dictate.

D) Sewage

Current laws and regulations pertaining to the disposal of human waste will be complied with.
