This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan and the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation. The surface to be disturbed is privately owned and a surface use agreement has been signed with the land owner.

- 1. EXISTING ROADS:
 - A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of an Eddy County, New Mexico road map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. From the junction of U.S. Highway 285 and North Canal Street in Carlsbad, New Mexico, proceed North on Canal Street, which becomes Eddy County road #206 for 10 miles. Turn right (East) on Eddy County road #237 and proceed 1 1/2 mile. Turn left (North) and proceed for 1/4 mile. Turn left and proceed for 3/4 mile. Turn left and follow rosd into location.
 - B. Culverts: None required.
 - C. Cuts and Fills: A one foot cut will be required for construction of the location.
 - D. Turn-Outs: One required.
 - E. Gates and Cattleguards: None required.
- 2. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:
 - A. Existing wells in a 1 mile radius are shown on Exhibit "B".
- 3. LOCATION OF PROPOSED FACILITIES:
 - A. If the well is productive, production will be transported to the Federal "V" production facility located in Unit letter "B", via a 2 3/8" steel flowline. The flowline will parallel existing roadways that have already received archaeological clearence thereby minimizing further disturbance. This flowline will be installed on the surface.
