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- B. The disturbed area will be re-vegetated by re-seeding during the proper growing season with a seed mixture of native grasses as recommended by the BLM.
- C. The reserve pit will be fenced prior to and during drilling operations. The fencing will remain in place until the pit area is cleaned-up and leveled. No oil will be left on the surface of the fluid in the pit.
- D. Upon completion of the proposed operations, if the well is completed, the reserve pit area will be treated as outlined above within the same prescribed time. The caliche from any area of the original drill site not needed for production operations or facilities will be removed and used for construction of thicker pads. Any additional caliche required for facilities will be obtained from an approved caliche pit. Topsoil removed from the drill site will be used to re-contour the pit area and any unused portions of the drill pad to the original natural level and re-seeded as per BLM specifications.

11. Surface Ownership:

The location is located on Federal surface. The surface is leased by JR Engineering, PO Box 12237, Odessa, TX 79768. Their representative has been contacted.

12. Other Information:

- A. The area around the well site is sandy grassland. The vegetation is native scrub grasses with abundant catclaw and mesquite.
- B. There is no permanent or live water in the immediate area.
- C. An Archaeological Survey has been requested and will be forwarded to your office in the near future.
