The applicant shall submit a construction traffic control plan for approval. The owner will protect, indemnify, defend, and hold the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department harmless from any injury or damage caused the owner, or third parties, by owner's failure to comply with the above. If this permit is granted, owner further agrees to comply with all the conditions, restrictions, and regulations, of the State Highway and Transportation Department. If not constructed, this permit will expire six months from data of issue unless otherwise noted and approved. The permittee shall notify the District Engineer of pending construction at least 72 hours prior to any construction, and upon completion of construction which shall be within 45 days of initiation of construction.
