4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES:

- A. The flow line for the NSLU No. 180 well will travel down existing lease roads 500' to the east where an existing North Square Lake Unit battery is located, or a new facility will be constructed on the well pad depending on well results.
- B. The power line will be constructed from the NSLU No. 180 well, to the existing lease power line located 150' north of the pad. See Exhibit E.

5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY:

A. Fresh water for drilling from surface to 500'+- will be obtained from a commercial source and trucked over existing roads. Lease brine water will be used to finish drilling and completing.

6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:

A. Any caliche necessary for surfacing the road and pad will be purchased from a federal pit located in the SESE Sec. 5, T17S, R31E.

7. <u>METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL</u>:

- A. Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the drilling pits.
- B. Drilling fluids will be allowed to evaporate in the drilling pits until the pits are dry.
- C. Water produced during test will be disposed of in the drilling pits. Oil produced during test will be stored in test tanks until sold.
- D. Current laws and regulations pertaining to the disposal of human waste will be compiled with.
- E. Trash, waste paper, garbage, debris or junk will be removed from the wellsite within 30 days after finishing drilling and/or completion operations.

8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES:

A. None required.
