Elm Ridge Resources, Inc proposes to plugback the Alexandra Ballard #1 to the Fruitland Coal in accordance with regulations as specified. We will notify the BLM office 24-hours prior to commencement of plugback procedures. Run a CBL w/CCL across Fruitland Coal @ 1183'. Set a CIBP @ +/- 4650'. Spot 200' cement plug on top of CIBP. Set a 100' cement plug across Mesa Verde from 1974' to 1874' inside and outside of 5-1/2" casing. If CBL shows no cement across Fruitland and Pictured Cliffs, Elm Ridge Resources, Inc will perforate @ +/- 1360'. Set a cement retainer @ 1300' and pump 300 sx (50% excess) Class "B" to surface. Spot 20' cement on retainer. Complete Fruitland Coal based on logs.
