Dear Bill:

Enclosed is Form C-102 which was prepared by S. R. Bullock and G. D. Noland on the well in the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄ Section 24-29N-11W. Although they indicate on the form C-102 that they intend to pull the 640' of 6" casing, this was never done. However they did fill the Farmington section with heavy shale up into the 6" casing and due to the fact that there was no show in the Farmington sandstone I believe that this should be sufficient. We are also enclosing an affidavit which we had prepared and which Mr. Greer signed, as he was serving as Oil & Gas Inspector for District 3 at that time. I hope that this will be sufficient to allow you to cancel Mr. Bullock's bond, because the present landowner refused to let him go on the place and he would undoubtedly be out considerable legal expense in doing anything further to the well. I donot believe in its present state there is any danger of reservoir co-mingling and see no reason why the bond cannot be cancelled.
