This well is a water supply well and has not produced nor is it capable of producing hydrocarbon.
As a water supply well, this well should not be required to pass a mechanical integrity test.

If we are able to revitalize the unit, we will need the water supply wells to enhance the performance of the unit oil production. Current economic conditions do not warrant the use of the well at this time, but it is an integral part of the unit and should be kept available to the unit.
