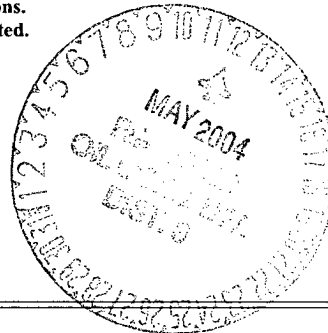

Intend to repair casing leaks to retain as water injection well.

1. Retrieve RBP at 3185'.
2. RIH with workstring and 4 1/2" casing swedge to tight spot at 5187'. Tag PBTD at 5368', POOH.
3. Run casing integrity log, evaluate.
4. RIH with workstring, RBP, and packer, test for casing leaks and locations.
5. Squeeze casing leaks with cement, to be determined as testing is conducted.
6. Conduct final mechanical integrity test.
7. Install IPC injection tubing and packer.
8. Return well to water injection status.
9. Work expected to begin 09/01/04.
10. Work to be completed by 10/01/2004.
