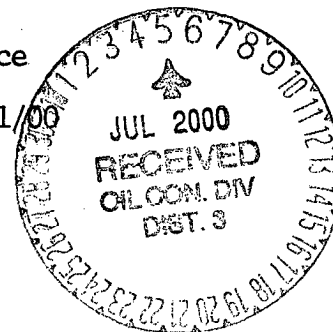

Dear Mr. Davis:

On July 5, 2000, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) received a Sundry Notice stating that Inter-Continental Energy Incorporated (ICEI) had plugged the R Fant #1, Unit Letter O, Section 24, Township 31 North, Range 02 East, API# 30-039-26436, and further stating the "location ready for release" and "pit still on location, will close by 10/01/2000". On August 23, 2001, we sent you a letter advising you of the violations. On February 27, 2002, we sent you a certified letter again advising you of the violations. ICEI has not responded to these notices and as of this date the well is still in violation of the rules and regulations.

An OCD investigation found the following:

1. ICEI plugged the R Fant #1 on May 8, 2000, (Per telephone communication between Mr. Perrin and Mr. Long.) and left the pit unclosed and no abandonment marker on the well.
2. ICEI has twice been notified of these violations.
3. Field inspections show that ICEI has not brought the well into compliance.

ICEI's actions warrant the assessment of civil penalties pursuant to NMSA 70-2-31.A. for the violations of OCD Rules. NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-31.A. authorizes the assessment of civil penalties of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per day per violation for any knowing or willful violation of any provision of the Oil and Gas Act or of any rule adopted pursuant to the Act.


In view of the seriousness of this violation, the Aztec District office of the Division believes some penalty and a definite commitment to future corrective action are essential. Unless this matter can be satisfactorily resolved we will request a show cause hearing before a Division hearing examiner, where we will recommend issuance of a formal order requiring compliance with OCD rules and a \$2,000 (two thousand dollar) civil penalty.






