

Reference is made to telephone conversation with Chris Roth, BP representative, on April 15, 2004. Per telephone conversation: It has been discovered that the reported bradenhead pressure is actually on the 5 1/2" x 7" annulus. There is no pressure on the 7" x 9 5/8" casing. BP request permission to perforate squeeze holes @ 3562' & perform a block squeeze. An additional bond log would then be run to confirm isolation of the proposed Chacra interval: 3562' - 3762'. After perforating and fracturing the Chacra down casing, additional squeeze holes will be perforated above the top of the cement to allow cement to be circulated to the surface.
