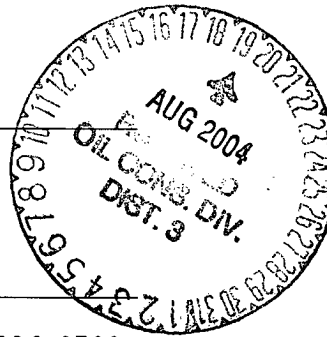

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to temporarily abandon the subject well as follows:

Move in, rig up. Trip in hole, set a 2-7/8" cast iron bridge plug at approximately 3391'. (Top perforation 3397'.) Call to arrange/schedule witness of pressure test. Test casing and cast iron bridge plug to 500 psi for 30 minutes. Record on chart using 1000# maximum spring and 24-hour maximum chart. Send copy of chart to the Oil Conservation Division with subsequent sundry. Leave well temporarily abandoned for potential recompletion.
