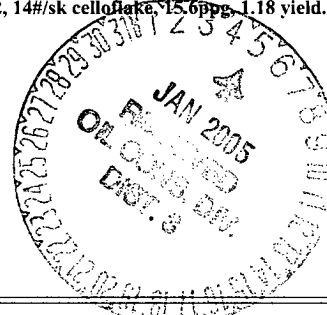

11/30/04: Spud well @ 8:00am. Drill 170' new 8 3/4" hole to 170'.

12/1/04: Drill 149' of 8 3/4" hole to 319'. Circulate, pump pill. Run directional survey @ 319' = 3/4 degree. Run 8 joints (300') of 7" 17# H-40 surface casing. Land surface casing @ 301' -1' GL. Circulate bottoms up.

12/2/04: Wash from 15' to bottom. Cement surface casing w/ 185sx Class B cement w/ 3% CaCl2, 14#/sk celloflake, 15.6ppg, 1.18 yield. Circulate 11 bbl cement to surface. WOC.
