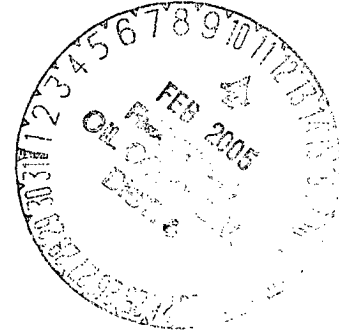

Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the **No. 23 Scott Federal 27-11** well, located **665' FSL and 665' FWL, Section 23, T27N, R11W San Jaun County, New Mexico**. This APD was approved on **January 28, 2003** with an expiration date of **January 28, 2004**. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location. In view of the foregoing, this office is rescinding the approval due to the expiration of this APD.
