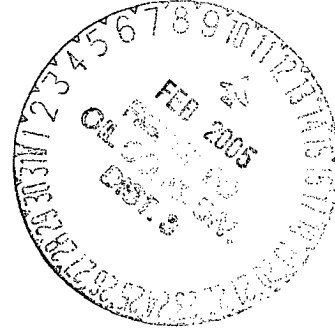

Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the **No. 22 Scott Federal 27-11** well, located **780' FNL and 1040' FWL, Section 22, T27N, R11W San Juan County, New Mexico**.
