



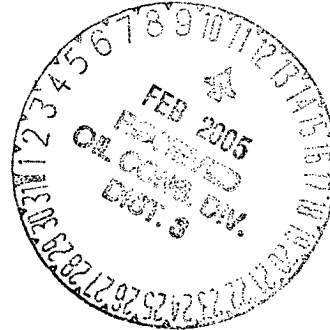

Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the **No. 102 BW Federal 33-29-8** well, located **748' FNL and 660' FEL, Section 33, T29N, R8W San Juan County, New Mexico**.
