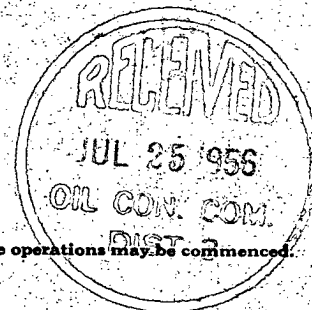

## DETAILS OF WORK

On June 22, 1955, a 31 sack cement plug was spotted from 1450' to 1350', a 50 sack plug spotted at base of casing (315'), and a 25 sack plug from 70' to surface. Hole was filled with mud between plugs. Plug and abandonment marker was set and ground restored to its original contours per regulations. Operations were completed June 23, 1955.
