Dear Mr. Mason:

Reference our conversation this date, we would like to leave this No. 1 Fairfield in its present configuration until about August-September this year.

In attempting to recomplete this well in a lower Dakota sandstone, which was unsuccessful, we had a half million cubic foot flow of gas from either a shallow coal seam or a thin section from the Fruitland.

We had planned to drill a Dakota offset to this well this past fall but were unable to do so. Our plans were to dig this shallow section with gas to determine where the gas flow came from.

This would then permit us to recomplete the No. 1 Fairfield in that pay zone.

We now plan to drill the offset in May-June this year. We may set casing on that pay or proceed on to the Dakota, depending on flow rate and logs.

You advised that you would give this consideration on the subject of an assessment.
