This letter is sent to you on behalf of our client, Redwolf Production, Inc. ("Redwolf"). Redwolf is the operator of the Subject Wells. San Juan Coal Company is currently mining coal underlying the Subject Lands as part of its operations in the San Juan Underground Mine. San Juan Coal Company recently notified Redwolf that it may attempt to forcibly plug the Subject Wells and mine through Redwolf's wellbores.

In the event that an application is filed with your office or permission from your office is sought by or on behalf of San Juan Coal Company to plug the Subject Wells, this is to advise that Redwolf does not consent to the plugging of the Subject Wells. It is Redwolf's position that San Juan Coal Company has neither the legal nor the contractual right to forcibly plug the Subject Wells or otherwise interfere with Redwolf's ongoing oil and gas operations on the Subject Lands. Redwolf views any attempt to access its wellsites and plug its wells as a waste of oil and gas and a violation of its correlative rights to conduct its oil and gas operations without interference.
