


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* The high side dump valve on the separator hung open for a 77 hour period, releasing natural gas. High side dump controller was adjusted and will be checked again this week by the field technician. The well continues to flow.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The gas released dissipated into the atmosphere so no clean-up action was possible.
